

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

Rudy Project SpA in its capacity as personal data controller (hereinafter, "Data Controller"), issues this information in compliance with the EU and Italian regulations on personal data protection, to show you the purpose and methods of the processing of personal data that you may provide during the navigation in this website (hereinafter "Website").

It is specified that the current information refers only to the Website and not to other third part owned websites that the user can possibly reach through links contained in the Website.

CATEGORIES OF THE DATA PROCESSED NAVIGATION DATA

The IT systems and software procedures used for operating this Website acquire personal data whose transmission is implicit in the communication protocols of the internet. This information is not collected to be associated with identified interested parties, but by their very nature could, through processing and association with data held by third parties, allow users to be identified. This category of data, for instance, includes IP addresses, domain names of the users' computers connected to the Website, URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) addresses of the requested resources, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained as answer, the numerical code indicating the status of the response from the server (successful, error, etc..) and other parameters related to the user's computer and operating system. This data is used for the sole purpose of obtaining anonymous statistical information on the use of the site and to check its correct functioning and is deleted immediately after processing. For needs related to operation and maintenance, the Site and any third-party services used by it may collect System Logs, which are files that record the interactions and which may also contain Personal Data, such as the User's IP address.

DATA VOLUNTARILY PROVIDED BY THE USER

The sending of e-mails to the addresses indicated on the Website - optional, explicit and voluntary - involves the subsequent acquisition of your e-mail address, necessary to respond to requests, as well as any other personal data communicated. The Website contains filling in forms, accompanied by specific information on the processing of personal data and, where necessary, requests for consent: we therefore invite you to read them before proceeding with the use of the form.

COOKIE

In compliance with the Italian Personal Data Protection Authority decree no. 229 of 8 May 2014, on "Simplified arrangements to provide information and obtain consent regarding cookies", the Data Controller informs you about the use of navigation cookies on the Site.

LEGAL BASIS AND PURPOSE OF THE DATA PROCESSING, NATURE OF DATA PROVISION AND CONSEQUENCES IN THE EVENT OF REFUSAL.

The Data Controller shall process your data in order to facilitate the navigation and to supply the services you can eventually request through the forms specifically created on the Website. Apart from that specified for navigation data and technical cookies, in the sections of the Website prepared for specific services at your request you will be free to provide your personal data for the purposes stated in the respective information, but failure to provide them may make it impossible to obtain the requested service.

DATA RETENTION PERIOD

The Data Controller intends to process the data collected through the use of the Website for as long as it is strictly necessary to obtain the purposes for which they have been collected. And, expired this period, for the times laid down by the current legislation

RECIPIENT CATEGORIES

The Data Controller will not disseminate the data, but intends to communicate them to internal figures authorised to process the data by virtue of their respective duties, as well as to external subjects when necessary. Such recipients, should they process data on behalf of the Data Controller, will be appointed as data processors by contract or other legal act. DATA TRANSFER TO A NON-EU COUNTRY AND/OR AN INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATION

Your personal data will not be transferred to non-EU Third Countries, neither to International Organizations

DATA SUBJECT RIGHTS

You have the right to ask the Data Controller to access your personal data and correct them if they are inaccurate, delete them or limit their processing if the conditions are met, object to their processing for legitimate interests pursued by the Data Controller and obtain the portability of personally provided data only if subject to automated processing based on his consent or the contract. You also have the right to revoke the consent given for processing purposes that require it, without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing carried out until the revocation occurred.
